We made a dialogue session for the drugs under the full moon at an ancient place where the Greek myth says Orpheus was killed
- 2010: I started the moving project “Papajo” in a bamboo cabin, making mojitos and Greek tapas at beaches and street food festivals
- 2012: We participate like Co-Organizers in the Greek-German mountain hiking forum, organized at the Alexandreio Litochoro Foundation by the German Consulate in Thessaloniki and the Konrad Adenauer Stiftung
- 2013: Olympolis Art Project this time celebrated the 100th anniversary of climbing the highest peak of Mt. Olympus with the participation of members from the famous Metropol Orchestra of Netherland and local artist’s musician. Also we organized concerts and art exhibitions
- 2016: The “Disco Kitchen” and “Folk Gourmet” culinary projects combined live DJ sets with live cooking of Mediterranean cuisine

- 2018: We created a last minute Urban Festival “Let’s Brand the City” at Katerini. Activating the local community to perform at the old market and open spaces with art exhibitions such as: theatre, street music, photo workshops, concert, DJ sets and graffitis and bmx/skate activities at the park
- 2019-20: I participated at the atelier for Greek festival managers Eleusis2021, Culture2030 Meeting at Go International WOMAX Academy Workshop, School of Tourism on Tour and submitted the proposal “Retroreality” for participation to the program of ECOC2022 Esch-Luxembourg. In December of ’19 we presented the interactive project “Photagogia” in an open school space yard with video installations and video mappings graphics with a collaboration of a Romanian artist team.
- 2021: We are preparing the polythematic project “PrometheusIX”, a dedication to the famous Greek composer Iannis Xenakis, with a collaboration of Kuniko Kato and her team, a world famous Japanese percussion, at Spetses historic island and Mt. Olympus/Katerini at the last days of June ’21.
- Also I’m preparing the Red20.online.barfestival a hybrid operation for my closed business. A project which was inspired due to the pandemic and with a future mindset.
